UNIVERSITY OF NORTH ALABAMA STUDENTMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The University of North Alabama (UM) requires that first-time entering domestic and international students, and visiting international scholars, provide proof of immunization against certain diseases.

The following immunizations and screenings are required: Tuberculosis(TB)screening, MMR, Varicella, Meningococcal Tdap, and Medical History Form

MMR: Measles, Mumps, Rubell**8**tudents born after 195@ doses of MMR at least 28 days apart after 12 months of age OR a copy of a lab report showing proof of immunity from Measles (Rubeola), Mumps, and Rubella can be submitted.

<u>VARICELL</u>A(Chickenpox/Shingles)Students born after 19792 doses of Varicella vaccine at least 28 days apart OR healthcare provideral mented history with the date of the disease OR a copy of a lab report showing proof of a positive Varicella IgG antibody.

MENINGOCOCC AMeningitis (A, C, W, Y)Students age 21and younger —Proof of immunization against meningitis given any time after the student's 16th birthday.

TDAP-Tetanus, Diphtheria, Acellular Pertus Students One dose with the past 10 years. Booster is required if the vaccines greater than 10 years old.

QUESTIONNAIREAII students MUST complete the Tuberculosis Screening questions. Further tuberculosis testing may be required based information received from the screening questions. A student with a positive TB screening test cannot attend class until followesting determines there is no active Tuberculosis disease. All TB testing must be performed in the United States

MEDICAL HISTORY FORAM students must complete the Medical Historym. This form should be updated annually.

Recommended vaccinations include Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Influenza, COVIDand Hepatitis B.

First-Time Entering Domestic Students

All first-time entering domestic students who enroll at UNA must submit proof of required immunizations in accordance with published University guidelines. Enrolling students must upload proof of the required immunizations via the <u>Patient PortalDocumented</u> proofincludes an official certificate of immunization, a photocopy of an immunization certificate, or written documentation from a physician. Stude

Students that have not completed the immunization requirements by the first day of class will be assigned a default temporary waiver and asked to schedule an appointment with University Health Services. Students the default into a noncompliance waiver may be prohibited from registering for classes the following semester. exceptionwill be made for students enrolled in a completely onliprogram. This exception will be mevoid if students enroll in oreampus classes.

International Students and International Scholars

Due to the disparity of immunization requirements among many foreign countries, all UNA international students and visitingscholars are required to be immunized as outlined by the University of North Alabama's guidelines. _Individuals should upload poof of the required immunizations via the <u>Patient Portal All</u> documentation submitted must be translated into English.
