UNIVERSITY OF NORTH ALABAMA STUDENTMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The University of North Alabama (UNA) requires that first-time entering domestic and international students, and visiting international scholars, provide proof of immunization against certain diseases.

The following immunizations and screenings are **required**: Tuberculosis (TB) screening, MMR, Varicella, Meningococcal, Tdap, and a Medical J.8 Tw 0.521 (an)e3J0.7edede 0 Th0.521 (an)e3J003

MMR: Measles, Mumps, Rubella- Students born after 1956- 2 doses of MMR at least 28 days apart after 12 months of age OR a copy of a lab report showing proof of immunity from Measles (Rubeola), Mumps, and Rubella can be submitted.

<u>VARICELL</u>-A(Chickenpox/Shingles) – Students born after 1979 – 2 doses of Varicella vaccine at least 28 days apart OR healthcare provider documented history with the date of the disease OR a copy of a lab report showing proof of a positive Varicella IgG antibody.

MENINGOCOCCAMeningitis (A, C, W, Y) - Students age 21 and younger -

tuberculosis testing may be required based on information received from the screening questions. A student with a positive TB screening test cannot attend class until follow-up testing determines there is no active Tuberculosis disease. All TB testing must be performed in the United States.

MEDICAL HISTORY FORMI students must complete the Medical History Form. This form should be updated annually.
