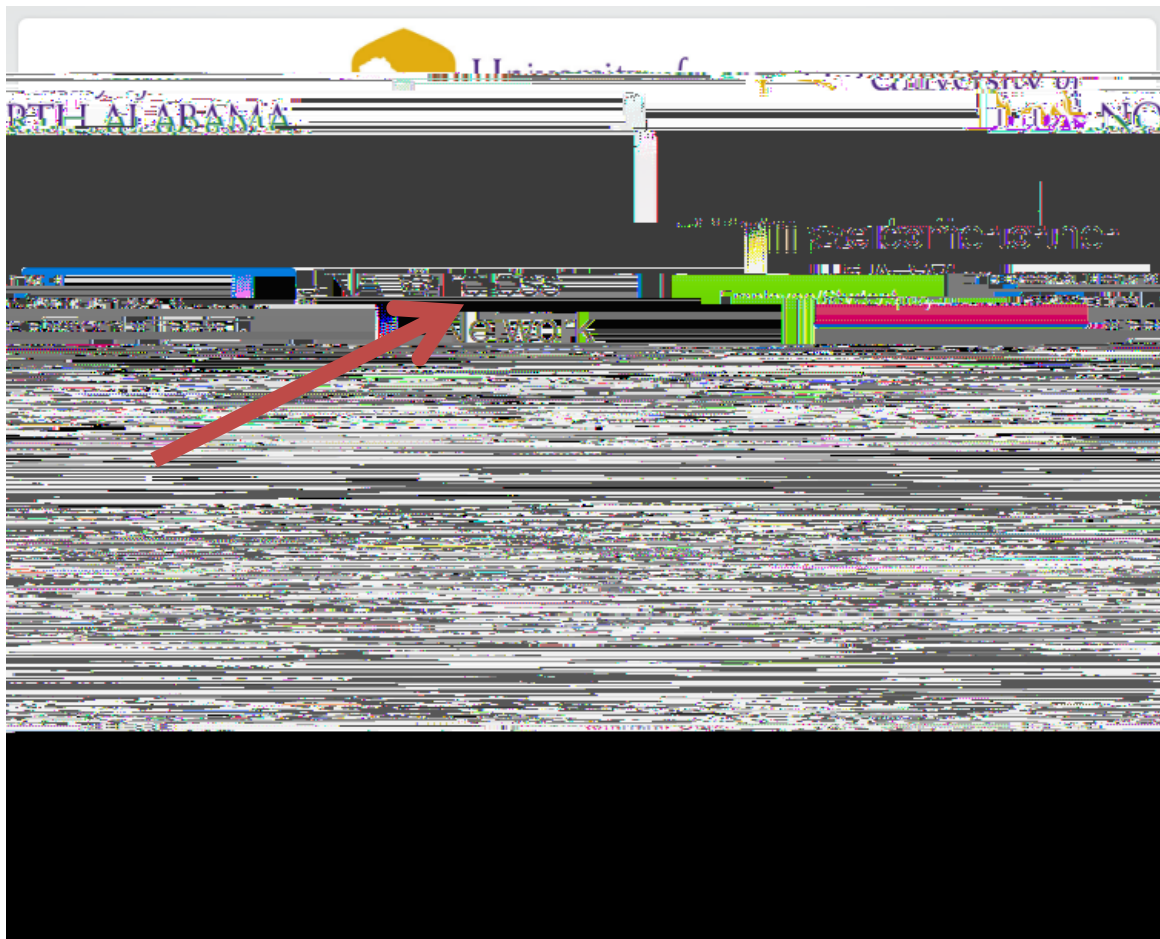


# Faculty, Staff & Student Guide for Connecting to Campus Wireless

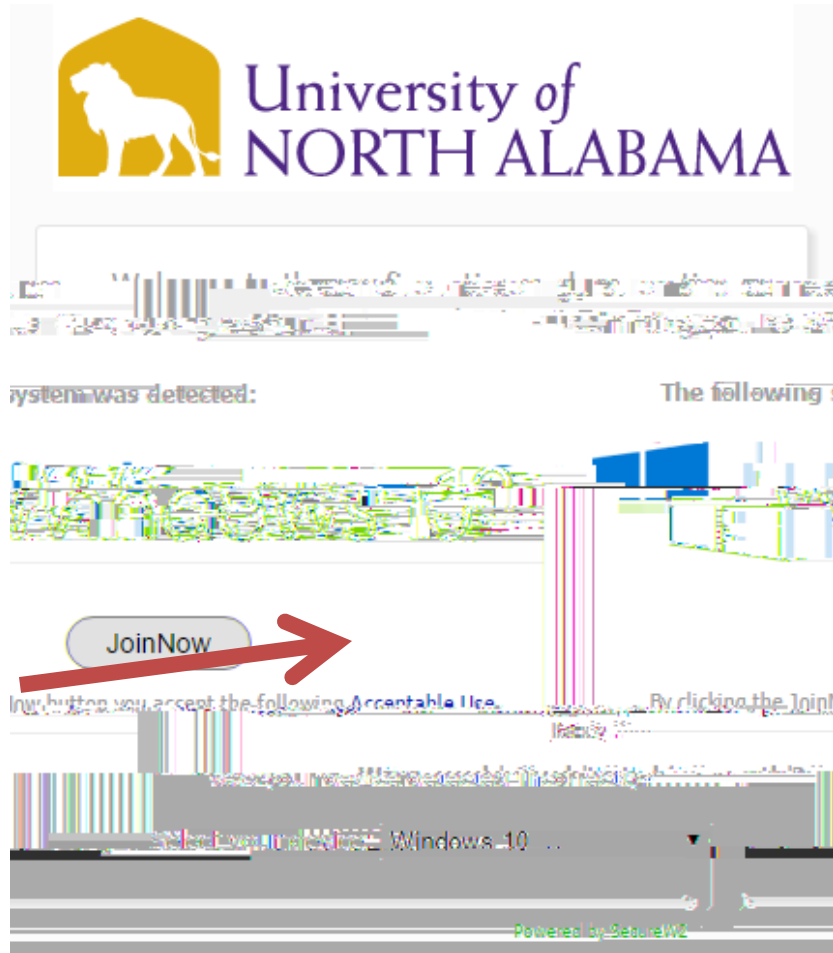
1. Select [UNA Start Here](#) in your list of available wireless networks.
2. When your device shows it is connected to "UNA Start Here," open a web browser.
3. At the welcome page, select [Employee/Student](#).



4. **Select your device/operating system** from the drop-down list if it isn't automatically detected.

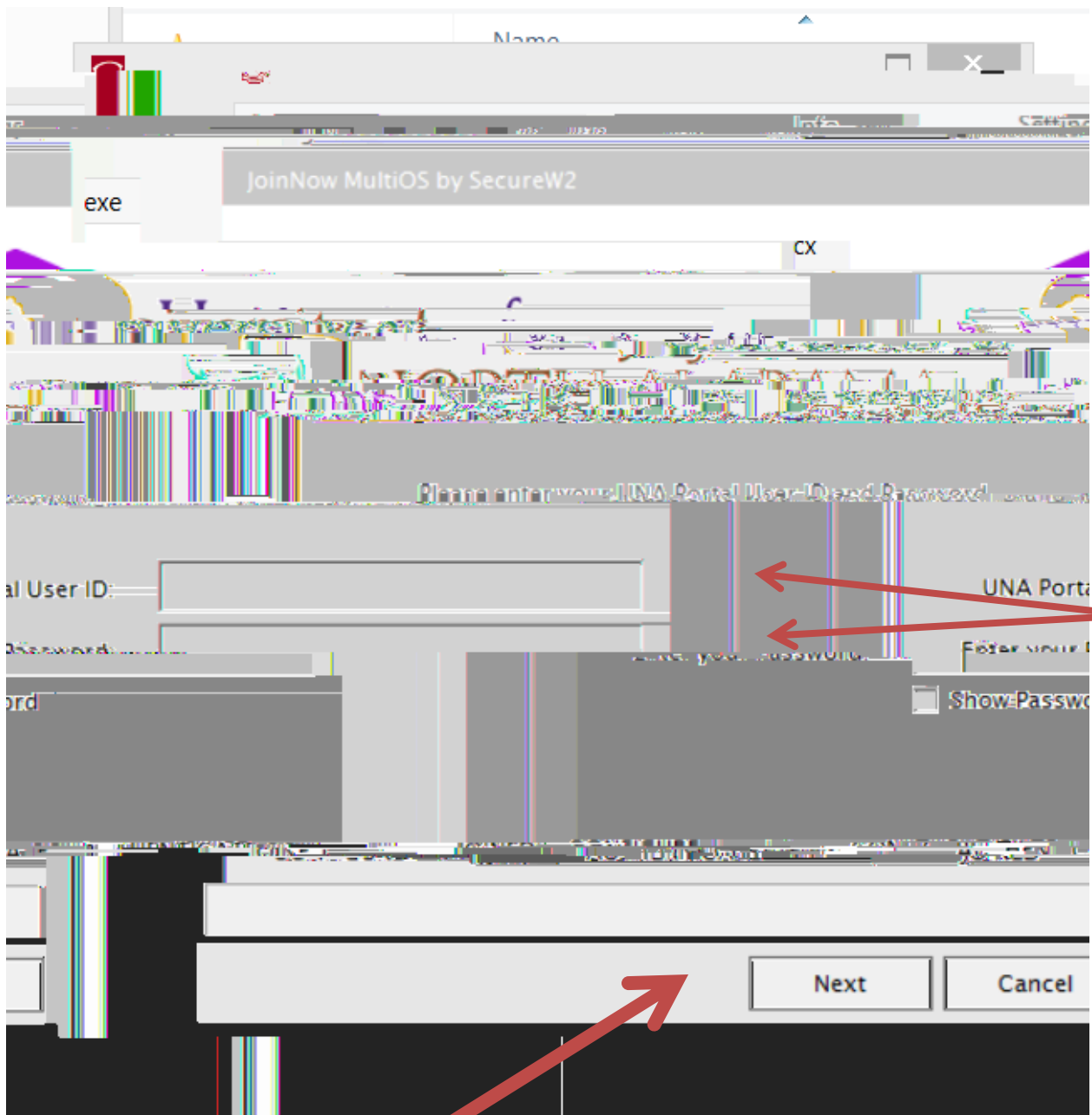
5. Select **Join Now**.



6. Depending on your web browser, click **Save/Run** when prompted.

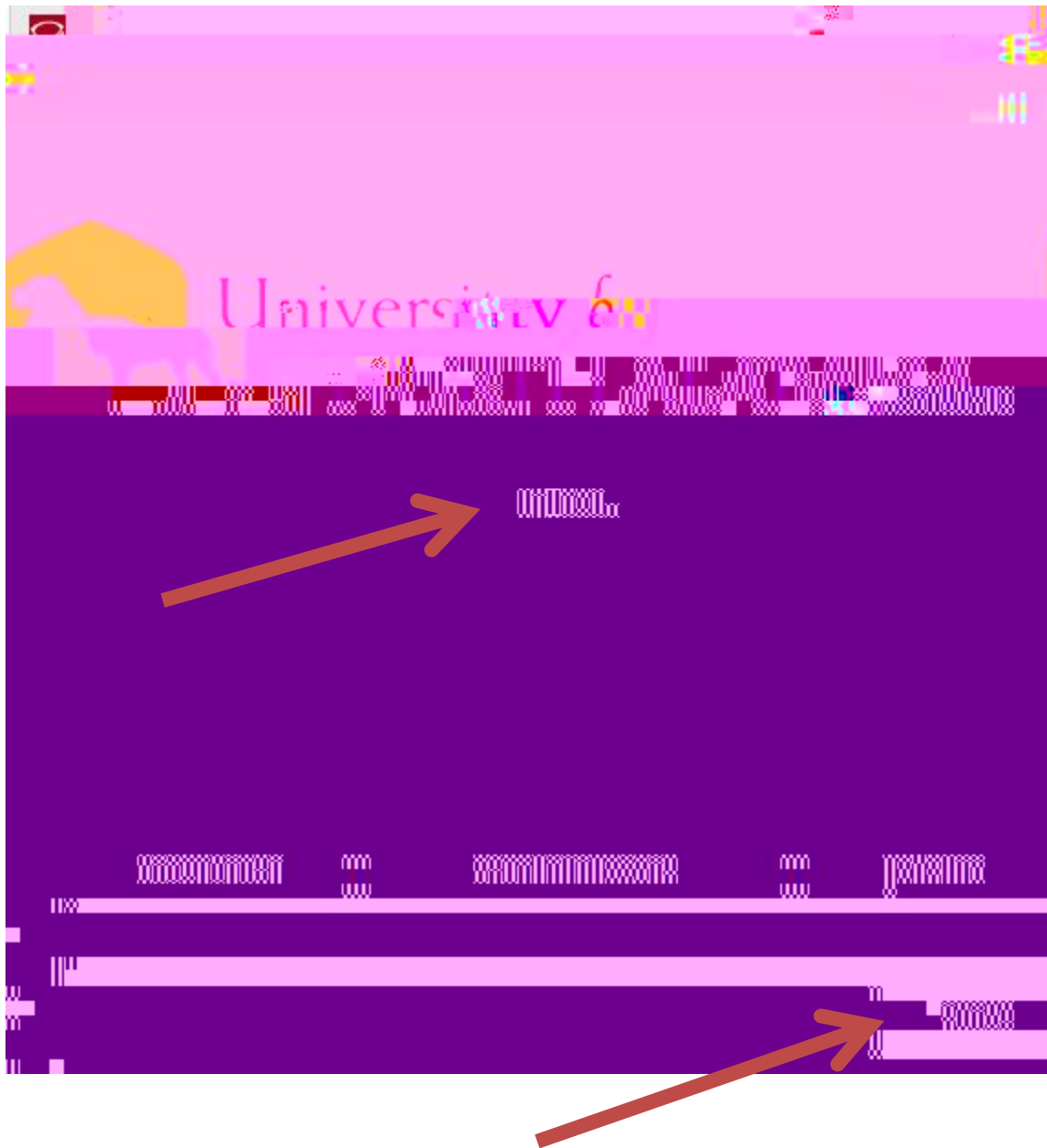
- a. If you selected Save, locate and run the file  
WiFi\_University\_of\_North\_Alabama\_wrapper.exe.
- b. If prompted by a Windows Security message, select Install/Run Anyway.

7. Enter your UNAPortal Username and Password.



8. Select **Next**.

9. After you receive the "Joined..." message, Select Done.



10. At this point you should be connected and able to surf. Depending on which web browser you are using, you may have to close and restart your browser.
