








Sexual Misconduct





UNA requires all employees to immediately report allegations of sex-or gender - based harassment or discrimination to the Title IX Coordinator by calling (256) 765-4223 R U by Suite 202 in the GUC. Sharing this information connects people to safety measures and enables the University to take appropriate action to address any hostile environment that may exist. Report behavior that yo u observe directly or are notified about verbally, in writing or through electronic communication. UNA's response is guided by the Sexual Misconduct Policy. 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Any instance of sex or gender-based discrimination or harassment should be reported. This includes instances of sexual assault, dating/domestic violence, stalking, non-consensual sexual contact, and sexual exploitation. Retaliation or potential retaliation for bringing forward information should also be reported.

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To reduce risks to the University community, all students, faculty, staff and visitors should make sure information about sexual misconduct is reported. Employees that are not confidential resources are obligated to report sexual misconduct to Title IX.

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
